


# A PERSONAL PERSPECTIVE - ELVA BAISLEY

They say that it is never too late to fall in love, get married and to live happily ever after, regardless of age. Elva Baisley and Ralph Weyer tied the knot on the 18<sup>th</sup> February this year. Both Elva and Ralph were at school together and went their own separate ways once the formalities of education were completed. Some 60 years later and a chance phone call, led to the friendship being rekindled.

Meeting up again was not a simple matter as Ralph hails from East London. Hours were spent on the telephone talking about the good times. Elva took the plunge and flew down to East London to meet up with Ralph. After about 6 weeks down in East London Elva came back. Ralph followed shortly afterwards.

Both Elva and Ralph became inseparable and it was only a matter of time before Ralph proposed.





Following her marriage, Elva has decided to limit her involvement with the Blockwatch as she will be spending a lot of time in East London. Known as the doyen of the Blockwatch, Elva was asked to put some thoughts down in writing about Ontdekkers Park South Blockwatch.

What prompted Elva to start a "Neighbourhood Watch" in 1989, was that the property across from where she lived in Finch Street was vacant land. Most of the time the grass was overgrown, pathways creating shortcuts to the Roodepoort station became ideal hiding places for criminals. Consequently, burglaries and even a rape took place on the vacant ground. It was also an excellent observation post for criminals to watch the comings and goings of

residents in and around the vacant ground. Today that vacant piece of ground is no more. The ground was eventually bought by the Methodist Homes for the Aged and the Summit Village was built.

After Elva experienced a burglary at her own house and having a purse taken from out of the entrance hall to her house, she decided something needed to be done. In those days, you could leave gates and doors open. Security was not an issue.

After another burglary took place at a home a few doors down from where Elva lived, she was spurred into action. Notices were typed out about the formation of a Neighbourhood Watch and together with son John, were delivered personally.

Initially Finch Street was to be the street concentrated on but other residents heard of this initiative and asked to be included. A portion of Juliana Street who had a system going amongst themselves asked to be included and from there the boundary was enlarged.

Thus, the Neighbourhood Watch was born. Those interested came together and the first meeting was held at the home of a Mr and Mrs Opperman on Ontdekkers Road. A committee was formed, subscriptions decided on, a logo chosen and boards made.



The committee met monthly and general meetings were held to inform residents. After a while, it was suggested that patrols be started. Once patrols started a decision was made to expand the Neighbourhood Watch and change it to a Blockwatch. A Randburg Blockwatch assisted Elva with the first logo and literature. Some may have seen this logo, it is a thief peering over a wall. It was after this that Ontdekkers Park South Blockwatch adopted its own logo which is still used to this day.

Elva is quoted as saying, "I don't think I need to tell of the heights the Blockwatch has risen to as it speaks for itself. This is due to the dedication of the present Committee and what has been achieved. As is said from small beginnings, great things happen."

Elva believes that all the Neighbourhood Watches and Blockwatches in Roodepoort have grown out of Ontdekkers Park South Blockwatch. Elva's parting shot to the committee; "May OPSB continue to go from strength to strength, and may the Committee continue to serve the community as they currently do."

 $8^{TH}$  FINCH - ANIMAL WELFARE = 2 Suspects going door to door trying to sell a dog. Investigated but unable to find them.
